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## VTM/Bulk Flammable Liquid Meter Notification of Seal Break

No person, or agent or employee of any person, shall use any meter or mechanical device for the measurement of oil, gasoline or liquid fuels unless the same has been proved in a manner acceptable to the Director of the Division of Oil and Public Safety and sealed as correct by the Director or one of the Director's deputies.

The OPS Director must also be notified immediately when a new metering system is placed in service or when the seal on an operating metering system is broken for any purpose.
