## Approved Continuing Education Courses for Conveyance Mechanics

Conveyance Regulations (7 CCR 1101-8 Section 3-1-1(5)) require that current mechanic licensees who have Type 1 and Type 4 conveyance licenses must show proof of continuing education training on escalators and moving walkways in order to continue to be qualified to perform work on these types of conveyances.
