Discussion of Third Party Costs by Martin Plank, Attorney Representative for Taghavi Re: Facility # 5271, Coal Mine Gas Express, 9819 W Coal Mine Ave, Littleton.

- Martin Plank, legal representative for Taghavi, Inc., addressed Committee members regarding litigation between Tagahvi and BDI (the adjacent landowner downgradient from the Taghavi property). BDI is proposing installation of a vapor barrier, and Taghavi asked whether the Committee could approve those costs as third party claims before costs are incurred. Additional information has been requested by OPS and will continue to work with both parties and technical reviewer for future resolution.
