MINUTES APPROVAL: September 18, 2020.

Susan DeMeules motioned approval with a correction to the attendees, and Tony Congram seconded. Minutes were approved unanimously.

STAFF REPORTS

- Month 2020 69 claims received in September, \$2,030,302.51 million requested, \$1,878,795.95 reimbursed.
- **Fund Balance** \$5.5 million as of October 15, 2020, however there is \$4 million owed to the general fund for a net balance of \$1.5 million. The average processing turnaround time is 82 days for Fiscal Year 2021.
- Applications not yet presented There are 38 applications from last half of 2020, 10 will be heard today.

OPS UPDATES/ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Mahesh Albuquerque gave a brief summary on the Fund balance and limited office hours at OPS. We will likely know more about the office working situation at the end of the month.
- Rob Herbert retired and the new Remediation Supervisor is Mary White.
- A new field inspector was hired and he will start in the next couple of weeks.
- The Annual Weights and Measures meeting was hosted virtually this year. Scott Simmons is the president of the association this year.
- The Deductible Waiver for 2021 was proposed to continue. Susan DeMeules motioned approval and Mahesh Albuquerque seconded. The Deductible Waiver for tanks removal was approved unanimously.
- In previous months a discussion was held about having a subsequent review to Original applications to determine if they have come into compliance. The review would determine whether a percent reduction should either be imposed or reduced/eliminated depending on the continuous compliance of the facility. Lukas Staks, attorney, explained as per statutes, whichever decision the Committee makes must stay unchanged throughout the remainder of the cleanup. A statutory change would likely be necessary. The committee may revisit at a later date.
