- **Fund Balance -** \$3.9 million as of October 15, 2020 in cash balance. The average processing turnaround time is 81 days for Fiscal Year 2021.
- Applications not yet presented There are 41 applications from last half of 2020, 11 will be heard today.

- OPS inspections and operational compliance numbers are trending back to pre-pandemic numbers.
