### **BEST PRACTICES**

#### **Training Course(s) Approval**

## **MARKINGS - Best Practice**

- No comments received from Safety Commission members between last meeting and current on draft doc.
- Document reviewed starting at White Lining (where left off last meeting)
- Discussion to combine sub-sections: 4(A) I, II, and III. Subsection 4 (A)(II) is specific to sewer laterals
  only.
- There are two types of sewer laterals, those that are electronically locatable and non-electronically locatable.
- Specific to statute subsection 4 (A)(II): Many older sewer laterals are not electronically locatable, however if the facility owner can provide best available information, they shall provide it. The excavator needs to use this information carefully. Facility owners may choose how to mark the sewer laterals. Facility owner and excavator are encouraged to communicate to share this information.

- Tom Sturmer resignation mentioned. Jeanette to serve as interim chair. Chris Kampmann offered to assist with the meeting.
- Large Projects Best Practice: considerations needed for chairing this best practice's subcommittee.
