The <u>Conveyance Regulations</u> require that all conveyance contractors be licensed by the Colorado Division of Oil and Public Safety (OPS) in order to erect, construct, alter, replace, maintain, remove or dismantle a conveyance within a building or structure. To be considered for licensing, the applicant must submit this application form, the information described in the Proof of Qualification section below and the application fee to OPS. Checks should be made payable to OPS and submitted to the address listed above along with the required documents.
