Welcome to Boiler Ownership in Colorado!

At the Colorado Division of Oil and Public Safety (OPS), we believe that you provide a valuable service to our community, so we want to help you navigate your regulatory obligations.

What We Regulate

The OPS Boiler Inspection Program regulates facilities with low-pressure heating boilers and high-pressure boilers.

- Low-pressure heating boilers:
 - Are either steam boilers that operate with no more than 15 psi steam pressure or hydronic (water) boilers that operate with no more than 160 psi water pressure and no more than 250°F operating temperature
 - Include domestic water heaters if the heat input is 200,000 BTU/hr or greater, 210°F or greater or if the water volume is 120 gallons or greater
- High-pressure power boilers:
 - o Are steam boilers that operate at steam pressures greater than 15 psi
 - o Include high temperature/high pressure hydronic (water) boilers that operate at greater than 160 psi water pressure and/or 250°F

If your facility has any of the above, your boilers are regulated by OPS.

Common Locations with Regulated Boilers

- Residential apartment buildings with six or more living units
- Schools
- Hospitals and medical clinics
- Office/commercial buildings
- Dry cleaning facilities
