The boiler owner or installer must submit the completed application to the Boiler Inspection Program via email to cdle_boiler@state.co.us or by mailing it to the address listed above. Please allow up to two weeks for the State inspector to schedule an inspection appointment.

Do **not** complete this application if you operate any of these boilers that are exempt from the regulations:

- Owned or operated by the federal government
- Located in a private residence
- Located in an apartment house with less than six family units
- A service or domestic-type water heater with less than:
 - 200,000 BTU/hr input
 - 120 gallon capacity
 - 210° F operating temperature

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Additional Documentation Required On-site

The initial inspection will include viewing the Manufacturer's Data Report (MDR), which should contain:

- ASME Forms P-2 or P-3 (for Power Boilers), P-4a or P-4b for piping and P-7 for Safety Valve, as applicable
- ASME Forms H-2 or H-3 (for Heating Boilers; cast iron and cast aluminum will not usually have an MDR)
- ASME Forms HLW-6 (for Lined Water Heaters) ≥ 200,000 BTU
