- I am applying for a Type 1 Conveyance Mechanic License according to 7 CCR 1101-8 Section 4-1-1(2)(a)(ii) or Section 4-1-1(2)(b)(ii)(III).
- I testify that, during the time frame of my participation in the training program approved by the Division of Oil and Public Safety (OPS) for which I have submitted a certificate of completion, my work experience consisted of at least 1,700 hours per year performing repair, maintenance, alteration, and/or construction activities in each of the categories listed in the Work Process Schedule (page 2 of this document). I also testify that these work activities were performed on the type of equipment described in ASME A17.1 and ASME A18.1 – Type 1 Conveyance Mechanic License.
- I understand that:
 - There are severe civil penalties for any false statement or representation of a material fact, knowing it to be false, or knowingly failing to disclose a material fact with the intent to defraud.
 - Section 9-5.5-118 Colorado Revised Statutes (CRS) gives OPS the authority to issue a notice of violation through Section 8-20-104 CRS, which may include penalty fines up to \$500.00 per day of violation and the revocation of the application for licensing for up to two years.
